In this new segment, we will keep you informed each month of items that have been considered by the members of your U3A Corangamite Committee.

At the March meeting, the following items were discussed.

Membership: it was noted that 155 members are now enrolled in 2019 (= to last year); however at the meeting two additional new memberships were tabled which make a record total of **157 members for 2019!**

Future Activities: more visits to historic homesteads and industry visits – canvas members to see if there is an interest in visits to Barwon Park in Winchelsea, the Fletcher Jones Precinct in Warrnambool and industry tours of the Corangamite Shire Depot and Stockyard Hill wind-farm - costs for local mini-bus hire to be investigated.
