Recently, the Secretary attended a U3A SW Victoria Regional meeting and at the meeting a representative from U3A Apollo Bay spoke about *MyValues - Make your Voice Heard*. The *MyValues* website is [www.myvalues.org.au](http://www.myvalues.org.au).

*MyValues* is funded by the Victorian Department of Health and operated by Barwon Health. With the *MyValues* website a person can register and log-on to create their own values profile that explains their values in relation to life, death and medical intervention.

Understanding and respecting your values will help your doctors and your family to make better choices about your medical treatment. *MyValues* can help sort out and clarify some very emotive issues that can be difficult to discuss, even with your closest family members – all in a very simple and objective way and helps you consider important questions and choices that may not have occurred to you. With this information, they can feel reassured that they are respecting your wishes.

At the recent Committee meeting, it was agreed that this was a good item for inclusion in the newsletter and for the information of our U3A members.
