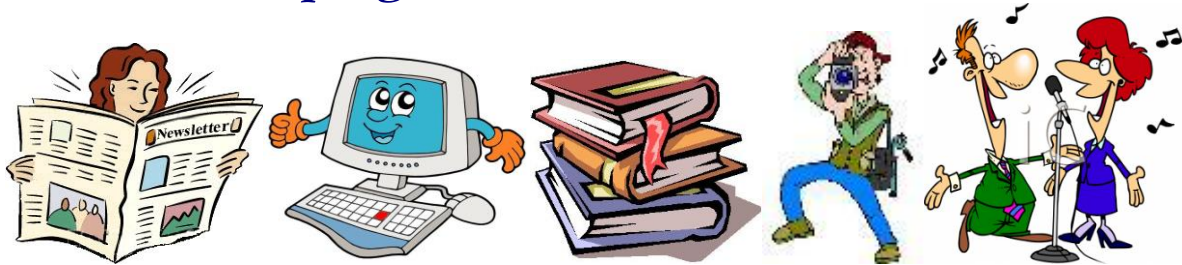

### ***DAY TRIP TO PORT FAIRY ON MONDAY 16<sup>TH</sup> MARCH @ 8.30am***

This trip is by coach leaving at @ 8.30am from Cobden and returning by 4.30pm

We have a reservation to tour “*Nature’s Way Eco Sanctuary*” from 10am. This property is on 6 acres in Rossbrook near Port Fairy and boasts a magnificent straw bale, fully self-sustaining house and gardens. Taking 5 years and 746 bales to complete, this inspirational home is sure to impress with its energy-saving features and eco friendly materials. The cost is \$25 for the tour and bus in total.

Lunch will be at “*The Hub*” restaurant, 15 Bank Street, Port Fairy (lunch at own costs). This café is adjacent to the Visitor Information Centre so you may like to browse there.

On the return journey we will visit “*Eclectic designs glass blowing studios.*” Depending on how busy they are the amazingly talented Robert Gatt and Freya Marriott may demonstrate glass blowing technique, but otherwise we can stroll through the studio and purchase items if you wish. No admittance fees. Then all aboard for the return trip!
