## ITEM FOR INFORMATION

We have recently submitted an application for U3A Corangamite to be registered as a charity with the Australian Charities & Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC).

Although the charity application is in the pipeline, ACNC is experiencing a delay in assessing applications due to an unprecedented number of applications that it has received recently as a result of the new ATO changes that affect Not-for-Profit organisations such as U3As.

Once ACNC registration is complete, it will allow us, via the ATO, to access charity tax concessions, including income tax exemption.
